- Three. THERE IS A WARRANT OR COURT ORDER**
- Four. POLICE ARE INVESTIGATING A SPECIFIC CRIME**

ANY OTHER TIME POLICE ASK FOR YOUR I.D.:

One. THEY MUST TELL YOU WHY AND HAVE A REASON - NOT RACE, NEIGHBOURHOOD.

Two. THEY MUST TELL YOU THAT YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO REFUSE TO GIVE I.D.

Three. THEY MUST GIVE YOU A RECEIPT WITH THEIR INFORMATION & HOW TO MAKE A COMPLAINT.
